Approve Minutes

MOTION: Barbara Meyers moved to approve the minutes of November 8, 2018. Joy Schwarz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Announcements and Reports

- November 19 Town Board of Supervisors approved issuance of building permits for some parts of Sandhill Farms
- Town Board asked the Planning Commission to track progress of the City of Omro in updating the Comprehensive Plan, especially the Land Use Plan Map
- Parks and Recreation: The Eagle Scout project is completed. Trail signs and a bridge have been replaced.

MOTION: Larry Remer moved to recommend that the Town Board approve the CSM with no conditions. Barbara Meyers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion of City of Omro Comprehensive Plan Updates

No new items were discussed and no motions were made on this topic.

Parks and Recreation Subcommittee 2019 Budget

MOTION: Rich Kern moved to bring the current motion from the last meeting off the table. Seconded by Barbara Meyers. Motion carried.

MOTION: Rich Kern moved to close the Parks and Recreation budget debate. Seconded by Brian Noe. Motion passed

By a majority vote, the motion which was brought off the table was defeated.

Members discussed the parks' maintenance and development budget. Brian Noe emphasized that the improvements to the parks must be kept within the monies that the Town of Omro is willing to pay. Future maintenance costs must be assessed and kept in check. Tom Tuschl suggested that the budget be changed to reflect a future desire for land acquisition for parks.

MOTION: Tom Tuschl made a motion to continue the discussion for another 30 minutes.

Seconded by Brian Noe. Motion carried.

MOTION: Chris Musha made a motion to recommend that the Town Board approve the Parks and Recreation budget plan as restructured. Seconded by Rich Kerns. Motion carried.

MOTION: Barbara Meyers moved to adjourn. Chris Musha seconded the motion. Motion carried.
