## Ordinance 03-1019

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Omro Winnebago County

The Town Board of the Town of Omro, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective October 21st, 2019, speed limits on certain Town of Omro town highways are reduced or modified as follows:

The speed limit on Hayfield Drive is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Buttke Court is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Buttke Lane is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Parlour Court is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Pasture Lane is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Cornhusk Lane is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

The speed limit on Fenceline Lane is reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph.

- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on posting October 21, 2019

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
