Meeting Minutes:

Announcements and Reports:

- Barb Meyers reported she is still researching park equipment and mentioned Lowe's has play structure plans that could be a possibility within budget.
- Mark Krings was present and reported on park maintenance. Trails were mowed, buckthorn trimmed back and another path at Schneider Wendt was cut in to give patrons an alternative path to use when there is standing water on part of the original path. Has not worked at Priske yet due to standing water.

Highway 21 Corridor Study:

Results of the recent Highway 21 Corridor community survey had been shared in meeting packets and were discussed at length. Next steps for the overall study were decided on.

- Bruce Roskom and Brian Noe will attempt to meet with WisDOT to establish a plan for future communication on any work to be done in the area.
- Work to gain an understanding for everyone as to what "commercial" realistically can go there based on conditions such as wetlands, etc.
- Come up with a more detailed plan than the current "big red stripe" and base it on each existing parcel to know what's actually up for discussion in each area.
- Meet with the school district to discuss any implications.
- Comprehensive Plan Amendment could be possible in the coming months.
