

VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN-PERSON

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office or other specified location during the days and hours specified for casting an absentee ballot in person.

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is Tuesday, February 1, 2022.

The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is Friday, February 11, 2022.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.

In-person absentee voting may take place at the Clerk's office on

Mondays, Noon - 4 pm

Wednesdays, 9 am - Noon

Or by Special Appointment (must be scheduled 48 hours in advance)
