FALL PRIMARY ELECTIONS

By now people who have requested absentee ballots for the fall primary should have received them. It is still possible to request an absentee ballot. The following link can be used to request an absentee ballot through the My Vote Wisconsin website: [Vote Absentee By Mail \(wi.gov\)](http://VoteAbsenteeByMail.wi.gov)

Even though the Town has multiple wards, this time all ballots will have the same information. The following table shows all the races with all the candidates. The order of parties was taken from the ballot. In all races it is possible to do a write-in even though that is not listed in the table.

You can only vote within one party. If you cross parties your ballot will NOT be counted, not even partially.

The ballot can be mailed to the clerk or returned in person. No one else is allowed to deliver it for you. Ballots must be received by 8:00 P.M. on election day August 9, 2022. Make sure to follow all instructions for the return envelope very carefully.
