REFUSE AND RECYCLING

Jeff Meyers, the attendant at the Town of Omro Refuse and Recycling center on Wendt Road, is attempting to get all users of the facility into the habit of displaying their passes on arrival. The passes are free and are required for entrance. WASTE MANAGEMENT ISSUES

Waste Management is a company that provides curb side pickup of waste and recycling materials for a fee. Lately it seems as if customers are confused as to when the company is providing pickup in particular neighborhoods. Garbage bins have been on the edge of streets in some places for two days instead of just the planned pickup day. This develops as a distraction (hazard?) to drivers on some of the Town roads that have narrow or no real shoulder. As far as this editor knows the Town officials have no real control over this service and cannot correct the problem.

AUGUST 21, 2023, TOWN BOARD MEETING

Before the opening of the Board Meeting there was a public hearing for the addition of a parcel at 4024 Marquart Lane into the Algoma Sanitary District. There were no questions.

At the beginning of the Board Meeting property owners at 4218 Hayfield Drive spoke to question the next steps to be taken by the Town to correct differences in grade between their property and a new neighbor.

The Board did the following:

Approved the addition of the parcel into the Sanitary District.

Listened to the “final” plans for the 175th anniversary celebration (see flyer at end of this issue).

Approved a temporary Class B retailer’s License for sale of Fermented Malt Beverages so that the Omro-Rushford Fire Department could serve at the anniversary celebration.

Waived the fee for that license.

Approved an Operator's License for Dana Woods to cover that same celebration.

Took no action on a property complaint on Reighmoor Road.

Approved the appointment of Dana Woods as Secretary to the Planning Commission following the resignation of Cheryl Gardner after years of service.

During announcements Board members were alerted to an upcoming discussion among Towns served by the Oshkosh Fire Department in the way of ambulance service and upcoming changes to the contract.
