

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF OMRO PLANNING COMMISSION

Present: Commissioners Chris Musha, Brian Noe, Joy Schwarz, Barbara Meyers, Tom Tuschl, Larry Remer.

Chairman Tom Tuschl called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

Approve Minutes

MOTION: Barbara Meyers moved to approve the minutes of August 9, 2018. Larry Remer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Announcements and Reports

- The Town Board approved the signage for Town parks and weed control
- Becky Geise will be using Schneider/Wendt Park Sept. 21-23
- A contractor is still needed to move dirt at Schneider/Wendt Park
- Project by Zach Lux has been nixed
- Wood chips have been spread in Priske Park by Brian Noe

Approval of Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation (COR) Plan

MOTION: Barbara Meyers moved to adopt a resolution to update the COR Plan (good for another 5 years) and to move it forward to the Town Board for approval. Seconded by Chris Musha. The resolution was adopted by a roll call vote of 6 aye and 1 absent. Motion carried.

2019 Budget for Parks and Recreation

Maintenance and costs of maintaining the parks was discussed. Brian Noe emphasized that the 2019 proposal is a good planning document but some items could receive lower priority than more pressing needs, such as Town road maintenance.

MOTION: Chris Musha moved to present to the Town Board a budget proposal/planning document covering Parks & Recreation activities. Seconded by Barbara Meyers. Motion carried.

Discussion of issues with use of parks

Continuing to discuss park maintenance, Chris Musha reminded the commissioners that WCS workers could be used to provide labor with less cost and fewer regulation hassles. Brian Noe re-stated the fact that taxes can't be raised for unspecified projects. Limited Time Employees may be hired for park work but these involve some extra cost and liability awareness.

2019 Calendar

A proposed calendar was distributed noting that the July meeting will be on the 11th and there will be no Parks and Recreation meetings for November and December.

CSM --Peter Remender and Robin Lucarelli, 3144 County Road F, Parcel Number 016-0683-01

MOTION: Larry Remer move to recommend to approve the CSM for Remender and Lucarelli with the conditions of one payment in lieu of parkland dedication and that a separate recordable document be included for the shared driveway. Seconded by Barbara Meyers. Motion carried.

Potential Fiber Optics network--QOS

Tom Tuschl presented some of the particulars of this company connecting cell towers around Lake Butte des Morts with fiber optic cable. They also have the intention of providing faster internet for the area.

MOTION: Barbara Meyers moved to adjourn. Joy Schwarz seconded the motion. Motion carried.
