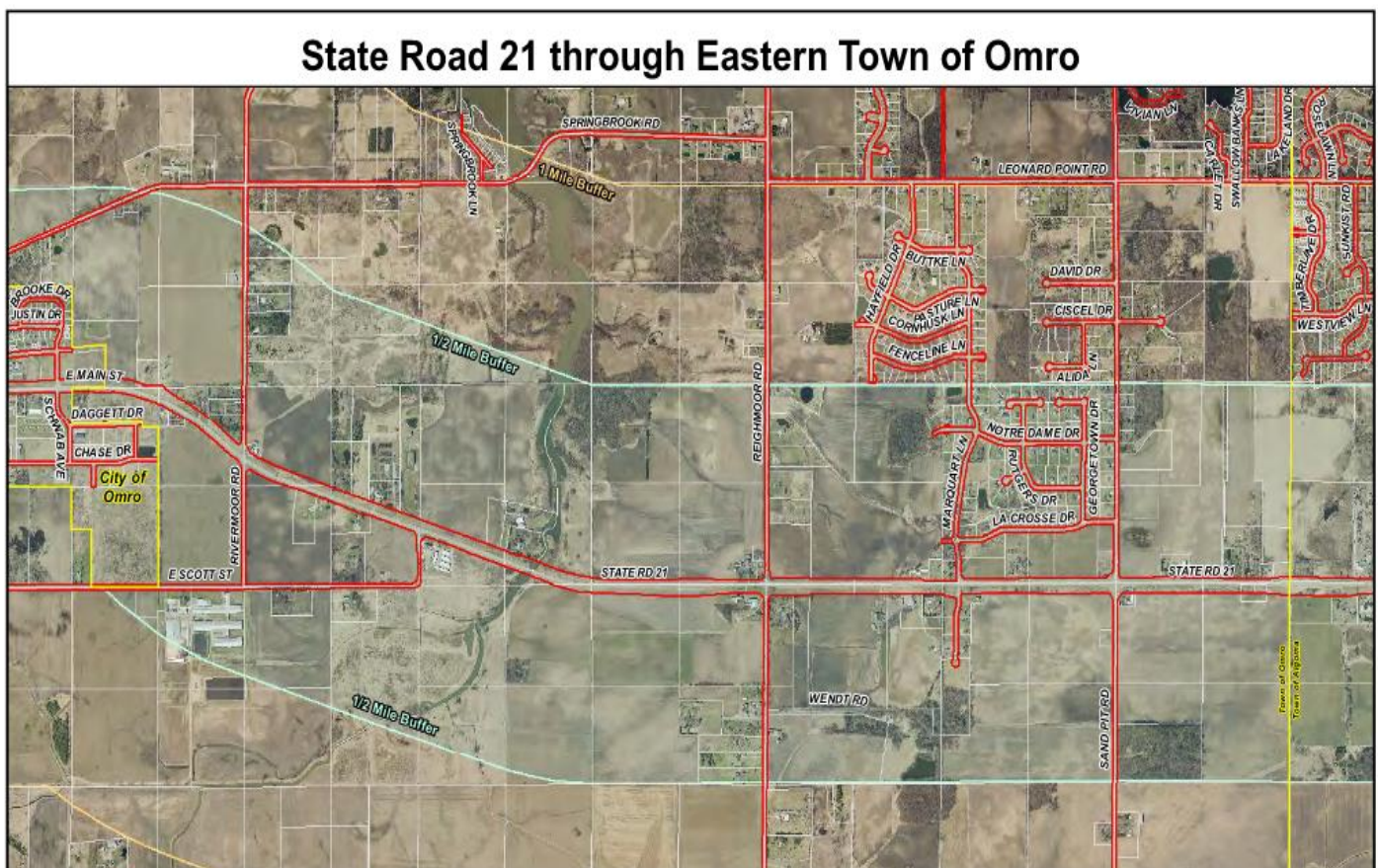


Your Input is Needed - Highway Corridor Study

The Town of Omro is working to develop a vision for how it would prefer to see the Highway 21 Corridor develop in a manner compatible with current uses, and leads to development that is aesthetically pleasing and projects a positive image of the town, while protecting environmentally sensitive areas and making the best and most efficient use of infrastructure.

To gather information, the town has partnered with UW-Oshkosh to assist the town in surveying our residents. The results of the survey will be utilized as part of the overall Highway 21 Corridor study, which will provide guidance to the town in reviewing future developments in this area.

The Highway 21 Corridor includes an area one half mile on each side of the highway and spans from the East side of the City of Omro to the Town of Algoma/Town of Omro town line.
